Note1	The subsidy pattern approved under the scheme will be as 50% in case of individual beneficiaries/ Societies/ Firms / Companies, 75% in case of institutional framework including Self Help Groups (SHGs)/ Joint Liability Groups (JLGs)/ Farmers/ Beekeepers Interested Groups (FIGs) / Co-operatives / FPOs/ FPCs, etc. and 100% for State Government / National / State level Governmental Organisations including NBB, ICAR, State Agricultural Universities, etc. For North Eastern Region, subsidy should be 90% for all individuals, institutions / organisations / societies / Co-operatives / Self Help Groups (SHGs)/ Joint Liability Groups (JLGs)/ Farmers/ Beekeepers Interested Groups (FIGs) / Societies/ Firms /Companies /FPOs /FPCs, etc. and 100% for Government agencies / organisations / departments, etc. However, for capacity building programmes including trainings, seminars, skill development for farmers / beekeepers, officials etc.,pattern of funding / subsidy will be 100% for allimplementing agencies.		
Note 2	Management support is @ 6%, out of which 2.5% for NBB and 3.5% to implementing agencies in field. In case of activities which will be directly implemented by NBB, management support @ 6% may go to NBB.
